## (1) OPEN JOURNAL SYSTEMS & PUBLIC KNOWLEDGE PROJECT

### significance

OJS is the world's most widely used scholarly journal management and publishing platform, with over 50,000 journals using it to publish their content. PKP is a research project that began over 25 years ago as an experiment about the impact that open source tools could have on the circulation of knowledge and on raising the quantity and quality of public knowledge. The impact of OJS and PKP on the academic community is enormous, especially in the Global South, where two thirds of the journals can be found. Every year, over 2 million articles are published using OJS, with around half of these in languages other than English. OJS and PKP innovate every year, supporting new publishing models and open science practices worldwide (including continuous publication, preprinting, open peer review, and data sharing). PKP's impact has been recognized through multiple awards, including a SSHRC Impact Award (Connection) in 2016 and more recently as a finalist to the 2024 Impact Award of the Association of Learned and Professional Society Publishers (ALSP).

## (2) REVIEW, TENURE, AND PROMOTION PROJECT

Set of 6 peer-reviewed publications and related infographic series from project analyzing Review, Tenure, and Promotion guidelines in the US and Canada.

### significance

The six publications, resulting from a project that I secured funding for and led are significant because: i) they offer direct empirical evidence on what is found in a representative sample of RTP guidelines from Canada and the US; ii) the empirical approach helped the community move beyond speculation on what is incentivized; iii) the publications have circulated so broadly that they shaped conversations among those influencing scholarly communication tools, practices and policies. This influence can be seen by looking at the widespread attention, including from Nature News, the Chronicle of Higher Education, Times Higher Education, Science Magazine, among others, and in 1100+ Google Scholar citations they have received, and in their inclusion as resources by groups like DORA ([sfdora.org](https://www.sfdora.org))

## (3) LARGE-SCALE STUDY OF OPEN ACCESS

### significance

This article was the first to use a new data source to establish on a large scale (using samples of over 100,000 articles) the extent of Open Access (OA) adoption across disciplines and publishers. In it, we identify that nearly half of what is currently published is OA, and shed light on a growing class of OA, in which articles are freely

available from the publishers, but are not openly licensed, making the long-term availability of these articles unclear. This article and the term we coined for this growing class (Bronze OA) have become a reference point in conversations about scholarly communications and OA. It received widespread media coverage (e.g., Nature News, the Chronicle of Higher Education, Le Monde) and has been cited over 1,400 times (Google Scholar).

#### (4) EDITED VOLUME ON LATIN AMERICAN'S OPEN ACCESS MODEL

##### significance

This edited volume offers a thorough exploration of the unique nature of Latin America's approach to scholarly communication; an approach that results in nearly universal open access. The book is the culmination of my dissertation project, where I shed light on the value of Latin America's Approach to Open Access, including the surprising finding that of downloads to Latin American journals come from non-academics. This book helped establish Latin America's approach to OA as a paragon for the rest of the world by covering topics such as: researcher's opinions of open access, national incentive structures for scientists, and the non-academic impact of research. The book itself has been cited 115 times (Google Scholar), with individual chapters receiving additional citations

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
